


COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility

Parents are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine if:

- You act as the primary caregiver for your children with a severe chronic medical condition OR with intellectual or developmental disabilities requiring a high level of daily care.
- You have certain conditions or disabilities that increases your risk of severe illness from COVID-19. The list of medical conditions is updated routinely as new data become available. Please click on this [link](#) to see the list of medical conditions.
